West Baltimore Help (www.westbaltimorehelp.org) is a non-profit that helps out folks who need a little Help in Baltimore by:

- Delivering bougie lunches, Pizza & Pepsi dinners, fresh bakery products, coffee and so forth to the street a few times a week.
- Setting up misting stations in busy alleys in the summer months where we hold picnics with fresh fruit and lemonade while folks cool off.
- Sharing hot food, coats, gloves, hoodies, sleeping bags, emergency blankets and a car to warm up in when temperatures fall - day and night.
- Triaging folks for signs of immobility, open wounds/infections, cardiopulmonary issues, domestic violence, burns, swelling, etc., and developing and executing care plans with them.

We save hospitals, police and fire departments money by directing Patients with minor medical problems away from hospital emergency departments and to clinics and medical trailers where their needs will be better met at lower costs, eliminating countless purposeless "emergency" calls.

We've been awarded both the President's Volunteer Service (Gold) Award, the highest award in the nation for volunteer service, and the Visionary Award from Happy Helpers for the Homeless, who have been helping folks in east Baltimore for over 33 years.

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Help With This Guide

Welcome to the Help Guide. Hopefully it helps you out. Few things:

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Overdoses - What To Do - Heroin, Xylazine, Cocaine, Fentanyl

If someone is breathing slow/shallow, they feel cold, and/or are cold/clammy to the touch, their lips and/or fingernails turn blue, and/or they convulse or become unresponsive to your touch, pain or your voice, they are likely overdosing on one, some or all the drugs above. Call 911 and administer Narcan in all cases (see Narcan Training in this Guide) and if they are not responding to Narcan, give them rescue breaths to promote breathing. Narcan does not reverse effects of Cocaine (a reuptake inhibitor) or Xylazine (a sedative), but does reverse the effects of opioids like Heroin and synthetic opioids like Fentanyl. Continue to administer Narcan doses in alternating nostrils every 2-3 minutes until person responds. If no pulse, initiate CPR.

DETOX

Consider Your Alternatives

Consider checking into a hotel, going home or to a friends place and tapering your use. The drop from daily Fentanyl use to Methadone or Suboxone and some comfort drugs offered by detox centers is too sharp of a drop in use for many people. You'll need a very trustworthy friend who is clean to make sure you are not too sick or too well on a daily basis, and ensures your use goes down significantly before going to a detox center. Detoxing your body from your drugs of choice will make you sick, but generally only for the first few days of detox. After that, you can pass the time by investigating work and/or school opportunities you want to pursue and move to a rehab center nearby.

DETOX & TRANSITIONAL HOUSING

Get Outta Town

The state suspended issuing new transitional housing licenses a few years ago citing extensive fraud and waste in the system. You can help with that by filing formal complaints against detox facilities, counsellors, transitional housing landlords, and hospitals/medical centers if you have problems with them (see Complaints section). In the meantime, transitional housing operators are highly incented to keep you coming back for treatment, not get you well. If you want to get and stay off drugs, you'll need to change your spaces, places and faces, so it's best to get out of Baltimore to detox and live. Generally speaking, if you stay in Baltimore you'll relapse. We included dozens of out of state Detox and Transitional Housing resources in this Guide, so consider going out of town or even out of state to get better.

INSURANCE

The federal government stopped subsidizing private health insurance in January 2026 and now requires re-enrollment every 6 months instead of annually. If you earn more than \$1,800 month (plus \$600 month for each family member in the case of a household), you are probably on Medicaid. If so, be aware that they are “considering” requiring 80 hours a month of “approved activities” which includes work or volunteering somewhere. There will likely be exemptions to the rule for childcare and school. The only way to find out if these changes will affect your coverage is to have a mailing address on file, so go to health.maryland.gov to update your address (see Safe Keeping section for places to send your mail). You can call 855 642 8572 for eligibility questions, and 800 284 4510 for benefits questions.
